Keynote Address by Mr. Shivam, CEO, Trans Neuron, Bangalore

In an inspiring keynote address, Mr. Shivam, CEO of Trans Neuron, Bangalore, shared valuable insights on the importance of cultivating curiosity and staying adaptable in a world of constant change. Emphasizing the need for fresh perspectives, he highlighted that, at times, it is crucial to step back, reflect, and articulate new ideas that align with evolving situations. "Sometimes, for writing new ideas and updating to current scenarios, we need to first understand our purpose and direction," he said.

He emphasized that in today's rapidly transforming landscape, learning shouldn't end at technical expertise alone. Rather, it should encompass the ability to question, innovate, and stay relevant in one's field. His thought-provoking words set the tone for an event focused on bridging the gap between present capabilities and future possibilities, leaving the audience with a powerful message about the role of inquiry and adaptability in professional growth.

Knowledge Sessions on Day 3

Knowledge Session on "Skilling India for the Future: Aligning Education with Industry Needs and Bridging the Skill Gap" by Mr. Madhur Mehrotra, Tech Adviser, Sales and Marketing, Murugappa Water Tech and Solutions Pvt. Ltd.

In a compelling knowledge session on preparing India's future workforce, Mr. Madhur Mehrotra addressed key challenges and solutions in aligning education with industry demands. He emphasized that, while knowledge acquisition is essential, a significant gap remains in the application of technical skills, business communication, and practical knowledge.

Mr. Mehrotra pointed out that schools and colleges often lack subjects focused on crucial soft skills, such as effective communication and business etiquette, which are essential in the modern workforce. He explained that communication should involve more than just talking; it should be a two-way interaction that fosters understanding, critical questioning, and active listening. This, he noted, is an area that requires enhancement in educational settings to better prepare students for professional environments.

Mr. Mehrotra encouraged students to cultivate a learning attitude and aptitude, advising them to "ask, listen, understand, and learn" rather than assuming they know everything. He emphasized that a true learning mindset includes developing listening skills, asking relevant questions, and avoiding assumptions. This approach, he believes, is crucial to lifelong learning and adaptability in a rapidly changing job market.

This insightful session underscored the need for education reform in India, with a focus on industry-relevant skills that can make students more employable and industries more competitive, ultimately contributing to national development.

Knowledge Session on "Alignment of Skills for Developing Entrepreneurship and Promoting Startups"

The Knowledge Session on "Alignment of Skills for Developing Entrepreneurship and Promoting Startups" brought together a distinguished panel of experts to explore how effective skills training can ignite a culture of entrepreneurship among students and aspiring professionals.

The session was led by insightful discussions from esteemed panellists:

Dr. B.N. Singh, COO of Weaver Bird Engg. and Tech, shared valuable insights on the technical skills and practical knowledge needed to support startup growth, emphasizing the importance of innovation and adaptability.

Mr. Piyush Pandey, Director of Geologix Technologies Pvt. Ltd., highlighted the role of emerging technologies in entrepreneurship and how aligning students' skills with the latest industry trends can unlock new opportunities for startups.

Ms. Preeti Goel, Ex-Managing Director at City Bank & Barclays Bank India, drew attention to the financial acumen needed by entrepreneurs, underscoring the importance of understanding investment strategies and financial planning for scaling businesses.

Mr. Hari Shankar Shyam, Educationist, Corporate Trainer, and Business Consultant, spoke on the significance of developing a growth mindset, leadership skills, and resilience to successfully navigate the entrepreneurial journey.

The panellists discussed a range of strategies for nurturing an entrepreneurial mindset, from ideation to execution. They stressed the need for a structured approach to skills training that goes beyond theoretical knowledge, incorporating practical skills such as problem-solving, financial literacy, business communication, and leadership.
