NEP 2020 IMPLEMENTATION FROM VISION TO REALITY



The **Higher Education Department, Government of Uttar Pradesh**, led a high-impact panel discussion on the practical adoption of the **National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.**

Speakers delved into how UP's academic landscape is actively evolving to align with the NEP's focus areas—including vocational education, multidisciplinary learning, regional language inclusion, and the integration of India's traditional knowledge systems.



Prof. Dinesh Sharma, Member Secretary, UP-SLQAC and NODAL for Bharat Shiksha Expo 2025, Higher Education Dept., UP highlighted policy adoption strategies, while Dr. Rajiv Kumar, Principal, Govt. Degree College, Noida and Prof. Kishor Kumar, Principal, M.B College, Dadri, G.B Nagar shared institutional reforms on vocational and multidisciplinary learning.



Dr. Deepti Bajpai, Professor, Sanskrit and Prof. Anita Rani Rathore, Principal, KMGG PG College, Badalpur emphasized the integration of traditional knowledge systems and regional languages.

EXCITING ACTIVITIES OF DAY 2

Day 2 of Bharat Shiksha Expo 2025 was filled with energy and innovation as students actively participated in a series of engaging activities.

22 Teams - 90 Bright Minds - One Hackathon that Redefined Innovation and Zeal!

A major highlight was the Hackathon, which saw the participation of 22 teams comprising approximately 90 students from renowned institutions like IIMT College, Galgotias University, Indraprastha College, NIET, and Moradabad Institute of Technology. The young innovators showcased their problem-solving skills and technical prowess, making the competition both intense and inspiring.



Hands-On, Minds-On: Over 300 Students Explored Science, Wellness & Creativity Through Nature's Workshop

The Nature's Workshop attracted over 300 students through its three immersive sessions. The Aarogyam activity, focused on blood group and blood pressure checking, was attended by around 100 students. The chemical testing segment engaged nearly 90 students in hands-on experiments, while the cosmetics-making session, where students learned to make lip balm and soap, witnessed a turnout of 110 students. Schools like Uma Public School, DAV Public School, S.S. Public School, and K.R. Mangalam School actively participated, turning the workshops into vibrant spaces of experimential learning and creativity.

Additionally, the **Robotics Workshop** continued to draw massive interest, with **around 200 students attending on Day 2**, bringing the total number of participants to approximately **600** across the first two days of the expo, as **400** on the opening day and **200** today reflecting the growing enthusiasm among students for technology and innovation.

Day 2 of Bharat Shiksha Expo 2025 saw strong engagement from students in activities designed to both challenge and guide them. The **quiz competition** drew curious minds from various schools, who enthusiastically competed across themes like science, business, technology, and general awareness. On **Day 2 total 36 teams** were there, **no of students were 144.** Students from **Sambu Dayal public school, Somerville School Greater Noida, SC. DAV, Ryan International school, K.R Mangalam school, Bloom public school, Rao Kasal school, Bal Bharati Public school, Mahamaya Balika Inter College, Kothari International school, Uma public school and APJ International school participated** in the quiz competition.
